Your honor I would like to express my sincere thanks for your attention to my earlier correspondence dated March 12, 2018. Please refer to it, which is attached to this communiqué. In that letter, as you may see, I was requesting your assistance in having the Honorable Judge Siegel address my Writ of Mandamus which was transferred from the Fourth District Court of Appeal, Case No. 4D17-2938, on October 11, 2017, docketed in the circuit court on the same date. 
Subsequently, based on a miss-apprehension, instead of addressing the Writ, I was sent a copy of an Order that had been entered for my pending 3.850 post-conviction motion granting an extension of time for the State to respond.

I am asking for the Seventeenth Judicial Circuit to address the Writ of Mandamus that has been pending for seven (7) months. The substance of the Writ is time sensitive and dispositive of my innocence in a DNA related case and the pending claim in the 3.850 motion. 
